This Year We Worked On:

- Conducted Alberta Numeracy Assessments and MIPI for grades 2-8, leading to data-driven discussions and innovative teaching strategies.
- Implemented 'Class Reviews' across all grades, emphasizing individual student progress and utilizing Learning Disruption Funds for numeracy resources and professional development.
- Introduced Positive Behaviours Intervention Supports (PBIS) to staff, formed a PBIS team, and crafted a PBIS Framework to be introduced in the Fall of 2024
- Fostered a sense of community through initiatives like House Teams, the Buddy Classes, "Skills Clubs", Community Movie Night, and Winter Market.

You Can Help By:

- Engaging with teachers to understand assessment results, support strategies, and reinforce positive behaviors and values at home.
- Engage in ongoing conversations about your child's progress, review PowerSchool with your child, and explore your child's online portfolio in MyBluePrint.
- Reinforce PBIS principles at home and encourage children to follow PBIS guidelines.
- Volunteer for events, encourage participation in extracurricular activities, and foster a sense of community both at school and at home.

- Implementation of a comprehensive PBIS program, emphasizing school-wide adoption and collaboration between home and school to create a positive and supportive learning environment.
- Implementation of targeted numeracy interventions and initiatives tailored to middle school students to enhance numeracy skills and improve academic performance.
- Cultivation of a culture of intrinsic motivation and curiosity among students by introducing innovative approaches to learning and integrating activities that emphasize the value and joy of learning.
